PUBLIC FORUM

Jonathan Thacker, Code Enforcement Officer, approached the Building Commission regarding Portageville Municipal Code violations at property owned by Harry Toton located at 106 W 5th Street. Toton was present with council, Susan Warren. Discussion followed.


Mayor Berry opened the floor for public comments on the property.

Alderman Adams made a motion to require the property to come into compliance and be deemed habitable by the Building Commission within 30 days. After August 12, Code Enforcement will be granted full access to the property for inspection to ensure the property is habitable and no longer considered a nuisance. Mayor Berry recognized the motion and asked for a second. Motion was seconded by Alderman McCrate. Voting was as follows: Alderman McCrate, yea; Alderman Adams, yay; Alderman Walker, absent; Alderman Johnston, abstained. Motion passes 2-0.


The Board of Aldermen, acting as the Building Commission, will hold a public hearing on August 23, 2021, to hear updates on the property located at 106 W 5th.
